PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

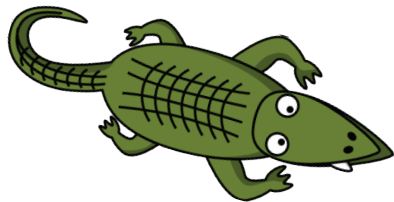
Dear Colleagues,
